Additional Fee Information

Tuition Fee – Tuition Fees cover operation costs, including overheads, salaries, education materials, school field trips and external examinations. It does not include items required for personal student usage, such as uniforms or personal school supplies.

Registration Fee (TZS 1,365,000) – Any new student who has been offered a place at our school will need to pay a registration fee in order to secure their place. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Re-enrolment Fee (TZS 1,365,000) – All continuing students need to pay a re-enrolment fee in order to secure their place for the next academic year. This will be deducted off the next payment instalment for the following year. It is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Capital Development (TZS 2,730,000) – This fee is payable at the start of each year, for every **primary** child enrolled at our school. It is levied as a contribution by the parents to cover the school's capital development. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Sibling Discount – A discount will be taken off the tuition fee for younger siblings of the same family, starting with 10% for the first sibling, and increasing 5% for each additional sibling up to a maximum of 20%

Clubs/ Extra – Curricular Activities – Clubs are arranged at the school and vary each term. These clubs are optional and are outsourced by external coaches. Fees vary by class type and availability. More details for clubs are given at the start of each term.

Cambridge International Assessment Exams – All examinations from Cambridge International are paid for by the school **provided tuition fees are paid on time**. If there are pending payments, or delays in payments the student will not be entered for the exams through the school and would instead need to be entered as a private candidate paid for by the parent.

Field Trips – Tuition Fees cover any non-residential field trips taken throughout the year. They also cover some costs for residential trips. Other additional costs will need to be covered by the parent.

Late Payment of Fees will incur a charge of TZS 70,000 per day to a maximum of 7 days. If fees remain unpaid, your child will be removed from the class register and online portals.

All dishonoured cheques will incur a fee of TZS 150,000. In addition, all bank charges will be levied against the drawer. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
